PRELATURE OF OPUS DEI

On 31 May, the Archbishop of Pamplona and Tudela, Florencio Roselló, presided over a ceremony in which the mortal remains of Eduardo and Laura were transferred. The remains of the couple now rest in the University of Navarre Hospital oratory, the hospital where Eduardo worked for 25 years and which Laura frequented.

During the homily, Bishop Roselló recalled moments of Eduardo and Laura's life, highlighting their mutual dedication and unconditional love for God. He emphasized that their true greatness lies in how they lived the Beatitudes with passion and dedication.

"We trust that this transfer of the remains, and this closeness of Eduardo and Laurita to us, will help us to get closer to God" said the Archbishop.

He also recalled that Eduardo did his doctoral thesis on the diseases related to malnutrition that affected prisoners at that time. The prelate stressed that this experience of human suffering undoubtedly left a deep mark on the life of the young doctor, who always knew how to see God in each of his patients.

Also in attendance were authorities from the University of Navarre, along with a group of hospital professionals, many of whom knew Dr. Ortiz de Landázuri personally and worked at his side.
