

Laura, trained as a pharmacist, devoted most of her life to caring for her family, generously, intelligently and with a strong faith in God, always attentive to the needs of those around her.

This book shows how human love and the grace of God transformed the lives of Laura and Eduardo. In their case, their mutual love and self-giving are also reflected in the fruitfulness of their marriage, blessed, as it was, with a large family. The historical and social context of postwar Spain is also present, but without diverting attention from what is essential: the story of a marriage that was, amid changing circumstances, a solid life project centred on God, mutual love, and service to others. The testimony of their children, friends, colleagues, and disciples adds richness and authenticity to the account. Laura and Eduardo, as a married couple, continue to give us a lesson in love lived in ordinary life.
