True love for the needy

sidoro Zorzano practised compassion and concrete concern for the needs of his neighbour. A religious Sister of the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament he met in Malaga writes about him: "He was outstanding in his love for the poor and for the less fortunate people, giving alms to them and consoling them with his always humble, sweet and compassionate words." (Testimony of Maria Luz Álvarez).

VERY GENEROUS IN ALMS-GIVING

He always had a preferential love for the weak and for people most economically and intellectually needy. A lawyer, childhood friend of his in Logroño, says: "No needy person who came to his house would not be helped by him. He shared in the sufferings of others." (Testimony of Ángel Villar).

He was extremely refined and discreet when giving alms to people, always saving some kind words when doing so. A friend of his recalls that he was very generous when it came to help in charity collections. However, he never wanted his name to appear in the list of donors. A diploma industrial engineer who was his student at the Faculty of Industrial engineering in Malaga, writes: "The few times I walked with him, I saw him helping the poor we met on the way, even when he was not asked for help. I was unable to see how much he gave; he did it in such a way that he passed unnoticed." (Testimony of Santiago Revidiego).

HE LOOKED AFTER ORPHANS

"He was involved in many works of mercy, especially with forsaken children.

He was possibly moved to do so by the example of the Father [Saint Josemaria Escrivá] who looked after these children in the Porta Coeli Orphanage in Madrid. He also spent lots of time in the Orphanage of the Child Jesus in Malaga." (Testimony of Juan Jiménez Vargas).

After fulfilling his duties, he devoted the remaining hours of the afternoons to them, as a subordinate of his in the Andalusian Railways recalls: "The Jesuits had a boarding school for poor and orphan children in Malaga. He was a teacher there and didn't charge for it. He spent many afternoons there and some Sundays went for walks with them in the country side." (*Testimony of Luis Romero*).

Whenever he was able to, he also helped other charitable institutions, such as the one run by the Sisters of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in Malaga. Some of the friends he made at the time testify: "Among his charitable works, what became well-known was how he got alms from people at Christmas time, to buy toys and sweets for the poor children of the Sisters of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. [...] Isidoro was always there, enjoying doing good, with his usual smile, not feeling proud about whatever he did, because his simplicity in all he did was remarkable." (Testimony of Victoria Prados). "His way of acting was exemplary in every way: he was always smiling; he was never angry; his greatest joy was to do good, especially to humble people." (Testimony of Salvador Vicente de Torres).


