

# 25 Years at Montalegre

The year 2026 will mark the 25th anniversary of the transfer of the remains of Father José María Hernández Garnica to the church of Santa María de Montalegre in Barcelona. His tomb, located on one side of the chapel of the Blessed Sacrament, allows his devotees to come and pray to him in person. Over the course of these 25 years, without any form of public worship, private devotion to Father José María in Montalegre has continued to grow. Every year, on the anniversary of his death, many people participate in a Mass which is offered there in suffrage for his soul. Other events have also been organised, such as the presentation of the biography Roturando los caminos (Breaking New Ground) and round tables on the occasion of anniversaries in the auditorium of the nearby Blanguerna Faculty of Communication. Publications for young people have been promoted, such as a picture book of his life, a biography for young teenagers, 'La historia de Chiqui' (The Story of Chiqui); as well as ebooks and audiobooks of the biography 'Abriendo horizontes' (Opening up Horizons). The most relevant aspect of this private devotion to Father José María known as 'Chiqui' to his friends and devotees - is the large number of people who come to pray at his tomb, not only from all over Spain but also the rest of Europe, as well as from distant countries such as Australia, the Philippines and Panama. Some leave a record of their visit in the visitors' book or book of intentions. As not everyone can come to pray in Montalegre, a communication channel has been set up imhg@montalegre.org - to receive requests for intercession and thanksgiving for favours granted. A committee of 'Friends of Chiqui' is responsible for doing this on his behalf and confirming that the request has been fulfilled. Colombia, Brazil, and Japan are some of the countries from which the most distant requests originate. There is no shortage of messages from devotees who share their intentions so that more people can join in, forming a 'prayer chain.' The favours granted by Chiqui are very varied. They range from domestic issues (a lost key, a computer that crashes) to more serious matters (success in competitive examinations, a broken marriage that is being healed, a serious illness). He also lavishes favours on Montalegre itself, such as financing the renovation of the church's roof and exterior walls which were in a state of serious disrepair. Chiqui is truly grateful to his friends
