
ST JOSEMARÍA, Today

In the parish church of Saint Josemaría in Medellin (Colombia)

Medellín.Colombia

In a populous neighbourhood of Medellín there is a parish dedicated to Saint Josemaría Escrivá. After a lot of effort, the new parish began its liturgical and evangelising activity on 12 June 2004. At the same time, health and legal advice teams have been set up, as well as various recreational and cultural initiatives.

The previous year the parishioners felt that the church should have a statue of Saint Josemaría to encourage devotion to him. Many people helped with their donations. An Ecuadorian sculpture workshop was commissioned to do the work, which produced a 1.8 metre statue from a mould made by Arturo Guerrero. The artist wanted to portray Saint Josemaría with a smiling attitude. It was installed and blessed on 10 November 2023.

Rouen.France

An icon of Saint Josemaría was installed in Saint Joseph's Church in Rouen on 19 March 2023. The parish priest had had wanted to do this for some time, and it has finally come about. Véronique Vié, the artist who created the icon, commented: "What the Gospel tells us in words, the icon shows us and makes present to us".

Montserrat. Spain

More than five hundred people from all corners of Catalonia took part in the blessing of the high relief statue of Saint Josemaría and Blessed Alvaro, which was placed on the road from San Miguel to the Basilica of Montserrat on Saturday 24 February 2024. The event was organised by the Association of Cooperators of Opus Dei in Catalonia. The work, in bronze, was made by the sculptor Rebeca Muñoz. On the base of the relief there is engraved a quotation from *The Way*: "*We go to Jesus – and we 'return' to him – through Mary.*" The abbey of Montserrat, near Barcelona, where Our Lady of the same name is worshipped, is an ancient place of Marian devotion, where people from all over the world go on pilgrimage. Among them, in the 20th century, were Saint John Paul II, Saint Josemaría Escrivá, and Blessed Alvaro del Portillo.

Kinkala.Congo

The first parish in Africa dedicated to Saint Josemaría is in Nkama-Bangala, a Congolese village about 6 miles from the city of Kinkala in Congo-Brazzaville. The country is so called to distinguish it from the neighbouring state, Congo-Kinshasa, which is eight times larger.

Our journey ends in two places in Asia. In one of the side chapels of the cathedral in New Delhi, the capital of India, one can pray in front of a statue of Saint Josemaría to ask for his intercession before God. Catholics are a minority in this country.

BIOGRAPHY

Saint Josemaría Escrivá was born in Barbastro (Spain) on 9 January 1902. He was ordained a priest in Saragossa on 28 March 1925. On 2 October 1928, by divine inspiration, he founded Opus Dei. He died suddenly in Rome on 26 June 1975. By then Opus Dei had spread to the five continents, serving the Church with the same spirit of full union with the Pope and the bishops that Saint Josemaría always practised. Saint John Paul II canonised him in Rome on 6 October 2002. His feast is celebrated on 26 June. His mortal remains rest in the Prelatic Church of Our Lady of Peace, Viale Bruno Buozzi 75, Rome.
